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#### WELLIES + OUTDOOR LEARNING

Can all children ensure they have Wellies in school – we are actively encouraging outdoor learning and suitable footwear and a waterproof jacket are essential. Each primary class will have an allocated outdoor day/session. On these days, please ensure your child has old, warm clothing on, suitable for potentially getting dirty but also suitable for the weather.

### <u>PE</u>

Children should bring a PE kit to school which can be left on their peg. PE Kit - plain white T-shirt, plain dark shorts/leggings/joggers are fine too, suitable non-marking trainers/gym shoes.

#### Water Bottles

Please ensure your child has a water bottle with them at school each day so they can access it at any time in the classroom - water hydrates the brain and helps concentration! We still have a few children continually coming for drinks through the school day which is interrupting their learning.

\*\*\*Please note only water for bottles in the classrooms – any diluting juice can be kept in bags for break and lunchtime

## SNACKS- We continue to promote healthy snacks Mon- Thurs with a 'Eat fit yi like' Friday.

#### FREE SCHOOL MEALS

In line with Scottish Governemnt initiatives, our Primary 1 - 5 children will now receive free school lunches. This is completed automatically through the dinner payment system so parents do not need to do anything to access this. 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#### HOMEWORK and GOOGLE classroom

Reading/Spelling homework will continue as previous years. Reading books etc will start to come home this week in P2-7. All clasess will have homework up and runing as normal by week beginning 4<sup>th</sup> September

Each class will again have a google classroom - once they have been set up, children will be given log in details to be added to the correct class. Log in details will be put in their reading record book.
